## Rules and Regulations

VENUE	Andover Rugby Club, Foxcotte Park, Hatherden Road, Charlton, Andover SP11 0TA See map on <a href="http://www.andobadoublefitastar.co.uk/entry.html">http://www.andobadoublefitastar.co.uk/entry.html</a>
ASSEMBLY & SIGHTERS	8.00 am : Equipment inspection & verification. 8:30 am : Assembly. 8:40 am to 9.25 am : Supervised practice session (45 minutes). 9:30 am : Shooting will commence.
RULES OF SHOOTING	WA rules of shooting will apply
DRESS REGULATIONS	Archery GB Rule 307 will apply
DRUGS TESTING	All archers will be liable for drugs testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or guardians must authorise drugs testing of junior archers on the entry form.
ROUNDS	Senior & Junior Gents Shoot 90m. Senior & Junior Ladies Shoot 70m. NB. The short distances (50m and 30m) will be shot on a 80 cm face. We DO NOT provide Junior rounds in this tournament. Disabled Gents needing to shoot a 70m round please contact the Tournament Organiser. Rounds will be shot longest to shortest distance on both days. Compound 30m and 50m targets will use two, six zone scoring faces per target, up to four archers per target.
AWARDS	Prizes for 1st, 2 <sup>nd</sup> & 3rd placed senior archers for double event (recurve & compound). Dependant on the number of entries for other bow classifications, prizes will also be awarded at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser. Awards for Junior Gents shooting the WA 1440 and Junior Ladies shooting the WA 1440 will be according to entry numbers. Trophies for recurve and compound Club teams. A recurve Club team must consist of four archers, at least one being a lady archer. A compound Club team must consist of three archers, at least one being a lady archer.
REFRESHMENTS	A selection of hot and cold refreshments will be available from the caterers in the Rugby Club on Friday and throughout the weekend. Meals can only be booked directly with the Rugby Club catering staff.
PARKING	Car parking, toilets and showers on site. Space for caravans and tents on adjacent field: refer to page 4 for fees and to book places.
FEES	See entry form (page 4).
ENTRIES	Entry forms with payment to be sent to the Tournament Organiser - cheque and postal orders only please. Tournament Organiser contact details are on the entry form (page 4).
LATE ENTRIES	Closing date: 30th June 2017. No substitutes or refunds after the closing date. Late entries subject to space being available. Telephone Tournament Organiser for acceptance before sending entry and fee (see page 4 for contact details).
PHOTOGRAPHY	All persons, amateur or professional, wishing to take still and/or moving photography during the progress of this event must provide personal details and sign the photographers' register which will be available at the Organiser's office during both days of the event.

## Rules and Regulations - continued

LIABILITY	Southern Counties Archery Society, Andover Archers, Old Basing Archers, Andover Rugby Club, Test Valley District Council, their servants and members do not accept liability for any loss, damage or injury.
DISCIPLINE	The Director of Judges is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times. Their decision in all matters is final and must be obeyed. The Tournament Organiser has the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour.
PARKING	All cars must be parked in the designated car parks or on the caravan parking area as directed by the Tournament Organiser. No cars are allowed on the competition field (the rugby ground) unless authorised by the Tournament Organiser and issued with a permit.
TENTS	Competitors are not permitted to set up their tents on the competition field until the working party have completed the field layout, and when notified by the Tournament Organiser.
WALKWAYS	The cross hatched walkways from the waiting line to the back of the tent area must be kept clear at all times.
ACCESS	<p>To allow access for emergency vehicles an access 'road' approx 5m wide must be kept unobstructed around the rugby pavilion and across the width of the field behind the competitor's tent area.</p> <p>This road will not be marked but competitors' tents etc, retailers' trading areas and advertisers' displays must comply with the instructions of the Tournament Organiser in respect of location and position.</p> <p>Trade stands must be at least 25m behind the shooting line, behind the line of the rugby pavilion and where authorised by the Tournament Organiser.</p>
FIRE RISK	Heaters and cookers are not allowed on the competition field.
CAMPING	Archers camping on the camping field do so at their own risk and should endeavour to make sure that their area is safe and does not cause an inconvenience to others.
PRACTICE FIELD	The Archery GB Rules of Shooting will apply on the practice ground.
SMOKING	Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is only permitted 10m behind the tent line; this distance will not be marked.
ASSISTANCE DOGS	Are allowed on the rugby field with prior notice.
